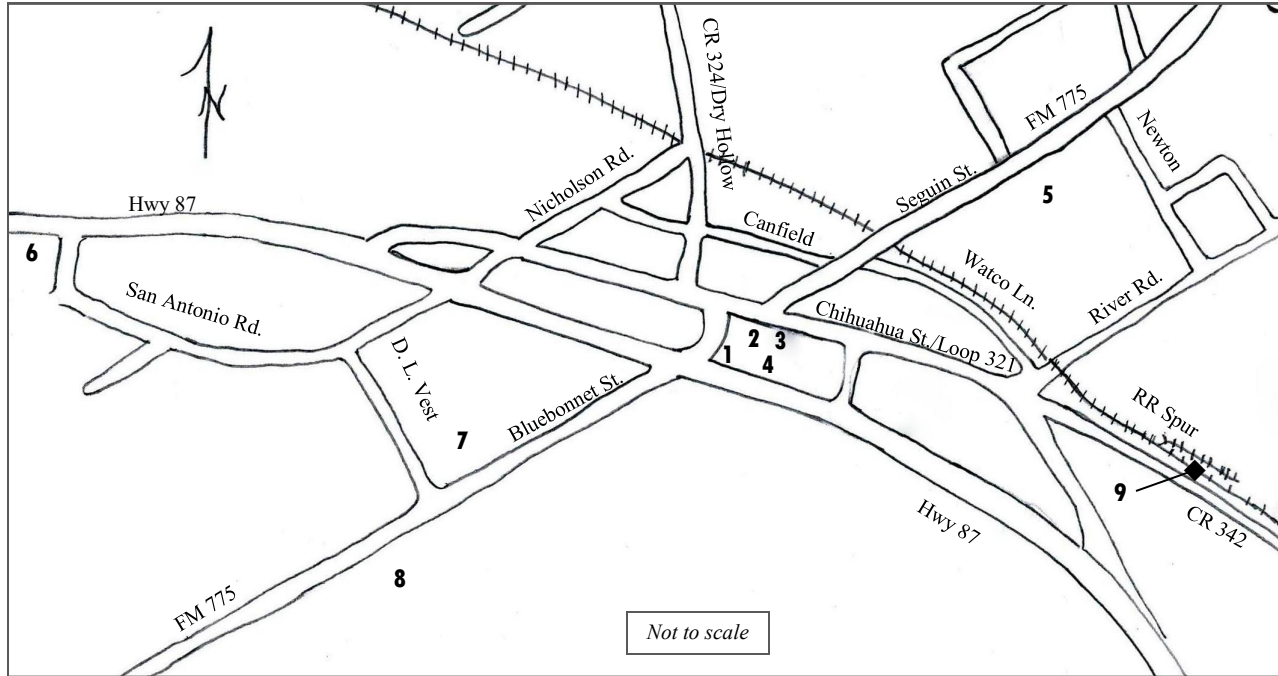


La Vernia, Texas Area Historical Markers



1. La Vernia Heritage Museum. Operated by the La Vernia Historical Association.
2. La Vernia. Recorded Texas Historic Landmark. Marker located on Tx Loop 321 (Chihuahua Street) in front of City Hall.
3. Old Chihuahua Road. Recorded Texas Historic Landmark. Marker located on Tx Loop 321 (Chihuahua Street) in front of City Hall.
4. Suttles Pottery. Recorded Texas Historic Landmark. Marker located at 13066 Hwy 87 W in La Vernia.
5. Immanuel Lutheran Church. Recorded Texas Historic Landmark. Located on FM 775 (Seguin St) N of Chihuahua Street.
6. Thomas Applewhite Homestead. Recorded Texas Historic Landmark. Located at 624 W Hwy 87.
7. Brahan Lodge #226, A.F. & A.M. Recorded Texas Historic Landmark. Located at the corner of FM 775 & D.L. Vest.
8. La Vernia United Methodist Church. Recorded Texas Historic Landmark. Located at 210 Bluebonnet.
9. Site of former train depot for San Antonio & Gulf Shore Railroad. Tracks removed late 1950s. Located on CR 342.

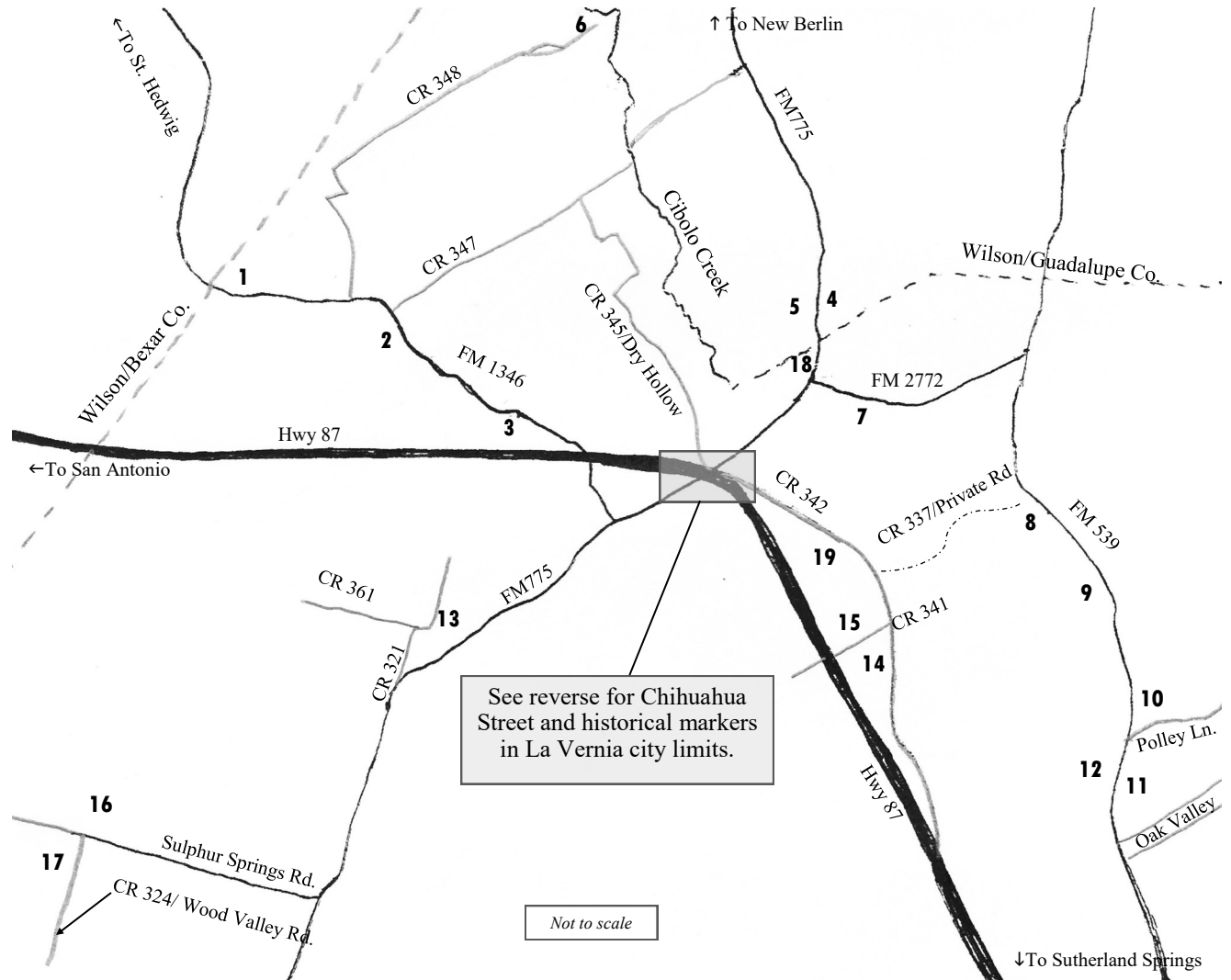

La Vernia, Texas - Area Historical Markers

1. Charles Carl Winkler House. Recorded Texas Historic Landmark. Located on FM 1346 N on Wilson/Bexar Line.
2. Beall Cemetery. Historic Texas Cemetery. Located 2 mi. N on FM 1346, 0.5 mi. W on Cemetery Lane. Other Names: Countryside Memorial Park; Bell Cemetery.
3. Immanuel Lutheran Cemetery. Historic Texas Cemetery. Located on FM 1346 N of intersection with Hwy 87.
4. Concrete Cemetery. Historic Texas Cemetery; Texas State Historical Marker. Located 2 mi. N of La Vernia on FM 775.
5. Deaf Smith Oak Tree. Famous Texas tree. Located in a field about 300 yards W of FM 775, about 2 mi. N of La Vernia on private property.
6. Albert Kosub House. Recorded Texas Historic Landmark. Located 4.5 mi. W of La Vernia off FM 1346.
7. Rector Chapel Cemetery. Historic Texas Cemetery; Texas State Historical Marker. Located less than one mile from FM 775 on FM 2772 on private road to the right. Other name: Wiseman Cemetery.
8. Mueller Bridge. National Register of Historic Places; Recorded Texas Historic Landmark. Located SE of town at FM 539 and CR 337 on private property. Marker reported missing Mar. 2008. Other name: Bridge at McAlister Crossing.
9. Barker-Huebinger House. Recorded Texas Historic Landmark. Located 5 mi. N of Sutherland Springs on FM 539.
10. Linne Oil Field. Texas State Historical Marker. Located at intersection of FM 539 and Polley Lane.
11. Polley House. Recorded Texas Historic Landmark. Located 3 mi. N of Sutherland Springs on FM 539. Other name: Whitehall.
12. Polley Cemetery. Historic Texas Cemetery. Located 3.1 mi. N of Sutherland Springs & Hwy 87 on FM 539.
13. Doisedo Cemetery. Historic local cemetery. Wilson Co. cemetery number WN-C134. Located on CR 361. From La Vernia take FM 775 S. Turn right on CR 321. Then right at CR 361. Cemetery is located at first left turn on right. Other name: Pleasant Grove Cemetery.
14. Cruse Cemetery. Historic local cemetery. Wilson Co. cemetery number WN-133. Located 2 mi. SE of La Vernia on Hwy 87. Turn left on CR 341. Go 0.5 mi.; cemetery is on right.
15. Britton-Robinson Cemetery. Historic local cemetery. Wilson Co. cemetery number WN-C007. Located 2 mi SE of La Vernia off



Hwy 87 on CR 341. Go 0.5 mi.; cemetery is 500 feet on left past Cruse Cemetery.

16. Kicaster Community. Recorded Texas Historic Landmark. Located on Sulphur Springs Rd. at CR 324/Wood Valley Rd.
17. Kicaster Cemetery. Historic local cemetery. Wilson Co. cemetery number WN-C060. Located on CR 324/Wood Valley Rd. off Sulphur Springs Rd.
18. Cibolo Crossing on the Gonzales Road. Recorded Texas Historic Landmark. Located on Cibolo Creek, downstream from CR 347 on private property. Also: Susanna Dickinson-Alamo Survivor. Markers located on FM 775 at Wilson/Guadalupe County line.

19. Wiseman Homestead. Historic local home. Located on CR 342 less than 1 mi. E of downtown La Vernia. Built in 1895. Private residence. Other name: "Dagger Hill."
